

## **BAC PARENT ORIENTATION SEMINAR**

- This is a mandatory one time Orientation Seminar that one or both parents must attend in order for their child to swim at Barracuda Aquatics Club. It is highly recommended that both parents, if possible, attend the meeting.
- The parents will also be required to sign the BAC Parents' Honor Code at the conclusion of the seminar.
- The seminar is conducted by the BAC Coaching Staff. It will be approximately 1.5 hours in length. There will be at least two seminars conducted during the course of a season, all the meetings will be conducted in the first half of the season. Parents are required to attend one meeting.
- If a child joins BAC after all seminars have taken place for that season, then the parent(s) must attend a seminar in a future season before their child can participate past the current season.
- This is a one-time seminar that will allow your child to participate in BAC for the duration of their swimming career, unless, that swimmer joins another team and then rejoins BAC. Then, another seminar will be required by the parent(s).
- The purpose of the Orientation Seminar and the Parents' Honor Code is to let the parents know the coaches' value system and to let them know that they play an important role to their child's swimming. The seminar will help define that role under the philosophy of the BAC program.
- College swimmers or swimmers over the age of 17 that are swimming in the summer season only, their parents will not be required to attend a seminar. However, if those swimmers are swimming with BAC during the fall/winter season then their parents will be required to attend a seminar.
